These two brothers were raised in a comparatively wealthy family in Asia Minor in the early years of the Church. They were educated as doctors, and believed that "of the most high cometh healing." They made a decision not to charge any of their patients, hence they are known as the "unmercenaries." They were known for their healing and their miracles throughout the early Christian community. Respected by non-Christians as well; they lived and practiced medicine to an old age. Ss. Cosmas and Damianos are the Patron Saints of the Philoptochos.
