Feast Day of St. Kyriaki – July 7

St. Kyriaki was born of very devout Christian parents on a Sunday, which is why she was named Kyriaki. She followed her parents' example by becoming a devoted Christian. She was imprisoned for being a follower of Christ and was severely beaten but she held firm in her commitment to Jesus Christ. She died at the age of 21.
