St. Marina – July 17

Marina was born in Antioch during the reign of Emperor Claudius II (AD 270). While she was walking to church at the age of 18, she was spotted by the prefect of the province, Olymbrios. For Olymbrios, it was love at first sight. When he asked her for her hand, she declined as politely as possible, explaining that she had pledged her life to Jesus Christ and was waiting for the moment when she could enter His service in some manner. Olymbrios' love turned to hate and Marina was tortured over an agonizing period until she was finally beheaded. Death came to this devout girl on July 17, 289 AD.
