Jefferson St. – Where's That?

107 Jefferson St. is the actual address of Holy Trinity. When the church was built, Jefferson St. ran from Suffolk St. to Market St. In the late 30's and early 40's, the North Common Village Housing Project razed all the buildings on Jefferson St. except for our church to accommodate the project.

On Thursday, October 4, 7:00 pm, at the Lowell National Historical Park Visitors' Center, 246 Market St. in Lowell, the Hellenic Culture and Heritage Society will sponsor a talk by noted historian and fellow church member Lewis Karabatsos, who will lecture about Jefferson St. during the early 1930's. He will identify residents and businesses within the buildings on Jefferson St. The program is free and open to the public. All are welcome. Come, you may find you have a relative on Jefferson St. The program is co-sponsored by the Lowell Historical Society and the Coalition for a Better Acre.
